The YRAW program is a full-time, 9-month RRC Polytech certificate program that provides skills and training to deliver positive recreational opportunities for children and youth. Students gain life and academic experience to be mentors, facilitators and role models in their communities.

The program is 30 hrs/week from **September - May**, which includes 300 hrs of hands-on work experience. Credits in this program are fully transferable towards the two-year Child and Youth Care Diploma at RRC Polytech.

Fees, tuition and books are fully covered, and students also receive a bi-weekly participant incentive based on their attendance.

*You must be:

- Between the ages of 18 and 29
- Available to attend full-time classes, Monday-Friday from 9:00am-4:00pm, with practicum placements 2 evenings per week
- Willing to obtain a criminal record and child abuse registry check
- Have excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Attend an information session
